

# SB280 HARMS FLORIDA TOURISM



#### **REASONABLE FEE**

There are no defined limits on registration or inspections fees. The lack of a definition allows local governments to charge excessive fees which can quickly become taxes for vacation rentals.



#### **REVOKE REGISTRATION**

This bill marries the local registration with the state license essentially removing preemption. There is no process for, or even right to reinstate a registration once revoked.



### NO CONSUMER PROTECTION

This bill provides for no notification or recourse for tourists being denied legitimately booked accommodations in the state.



## **MAXIMUM OCCUPANCY**

Strict bedrooms definitions and limitations on occupancy impacts family travel more than the intended "party houses". It is estimated to impact around 40% of all Florida vacation rentals This policy will drive families to seek friendlier accommodations outside of Florida..



## **UNDEFINED VIOLATIONS**

Local governments can suspend or revoke registrations based on undefined "material" violations. A definition should be in place to ensure uniformity, prevent bias, and protect property rights.
